



Cwmbran & District Pool League General Rules
Dated 4th April 2023

- 1] The game should be played in a sportsman like manner.
- 2] Playing format is 10 singles. A player may play in the 1st set of 5 and the 2nd set of 5.
A player cannot play twice in either set.
- 3] Matches to commence at 8pm. If the away team has not turned up by 8.15pm the first frame may be claimed. If they have not turned up by 8.30pm the home team will be awarded the highest points of the night in their division. Plus 6 frames .
- 4] A minimum of 3 players must be present to start the match. If the team does not have 5 players the opposing team will be awarded the frame for the absent players. A name must be put down against a no player but will not be awarded any stats for that game.
- 5] No cancellations are permitted. 1st missed game 1 point will be deducted 2nd missed game 2 points will be deducted 3rd missed games team will be will expelled from the league. 2 consecutive games missed the team will be expelled. All points will be deleted from the league table. If a team is expelled, the players registered for the team will not be allowed to transfer to another team until they appear before the committee.
- 6] There will be no conferring with the Ref or any players other than to confirm a rule with the Ref at the table of play.
- 7] Players must lag for the first frame of the match. Breaks are then alternate for the remainder of the match.
- 8] Full ball snookers and frozen balls are to be called by the player and not the referee.
- 9] Teams who finish level on points in first or second place. Frames conceded will be looked at, wins between both sides. If after this the teams are still equal then it will be a play-off to decide the overall winner.
- 10] Any team who withdraws or is expelled from the league any points won or lost by them will be cancelled for the season. They will also lose their good faith.
- 11] The minute rule should be adhered to. After 30 seconds referee to tell the player he/she has a further 30 seconds in which to play the shot, if the player fails to take the shot after this time, then it is deemed to be a foul.
- 12] All cards must be completed correctly with both Christian & surname in full {no nicknames} and signed by both captains. Incorrect cards will be interpreted by the committee whose decision is final. It is the responsibility of the winning team to send in the result. In the case of a draw it is the home teams responsibility. Cards to be e-mailed by midnight the day following the match i.e. Monday and Thursday. Late cards 1 point will be deducted from the a fending team.
- 13] New players can play at any time in the first half of the season provided they have not played for any other team. After halfway any new players have to be text or emailed to the Fixture secretary
