

- 14] Points 3 for a win 2 for a draw and 1 for the losing team if they have won 3 frames .Also a bonus point if your team wins 8-2 9-1 or 10-0 .
 - 15] A player may transfer once per season with a transfer fee of £5. The player must contact a committee member first with his/her request to transfer. In order for the transfer to go through the fee must be paid to the treasurer. It is the players responsibility to inform their existing captain that they are transferring to another team as a matter of courtesy.
 - 16] Set up of the rack 2 reds are to be placed at the top of the rack. No one except the ref can set up the rack.
 - 17] The type of match balls is to be the choice of the home team. They need to be of a good standard.
 - 18] Tables should be clean and tidy for the matches a standard rest and spider should also be Available. If a player cannot play a legal shot the frame should be restarted with the same player breaking. Assessment of the tables and venues will be carried out by the committee and only the best will be used for final rounds of competitions
 - 19] Players on Pub watch will not be allowed to play in the league.
 - 20] Good faith may be held if fixtures are not completed.
 - 21] League fees are not refundable.
 - 22] The committee's decision in all matters is final.
 - 23] Abuse of committee members or players if proved, will result in a ban from the league for the rest of the existing season and the following season as a minimum. Abuse to be clarified as verbal, physical and social media abuse.
 - 24] Complaints must be made by text to the committee.
 - 25] If arbitration is required during a match a member of the committee should be contacted for a ruling.

- 26] All fees either league or competitions must be paid at the time of entry.
 - 27] In the doubles or scotch competitions players can play with any registered player from any divisions as long as they have played the necessary number of games. 1 player cannot play on their own.
 - 28] Knockout cup early rounds preliminary or first round any registered player can play either by having played a game or being registered on teams entry form. Later rounds players must have played 3 league games on 3 separate weeks. The 3 game rule applies to all competitions.
 - 29] Competitions may be played on a day other than a Wednesday or Sunday to facilitate the smooth running of the league. Competition roll call 7-45 start 8pm..
 - 30] Failure to inform the Fixture Secretary of the competition knockout cup or plate result within 48 hours of the match being played will result in that person persons or team not being put to the next round.
 - 31] Landlords to be given the option to have competition played at there venues as long as they open the table. A box will be on competition forms to tick if they want venues.
 - 32] Players who transfer to a new team, but have already played in the preliminary or 1st round of |Knock out cup, are then cip tied.
 - 33] Summer League will be drawn from the divisions in the previous winter league untill a league is formed the number of divisions at the committee's discretion
 - 34] In competitions players will lag for break at the start of the match.
 - 35] If a team plays an unregistered or eligible player in the league all points will be removed In competitions they will be removed from the draw.
 - 36] All teams to abide by the Cwmbran and District Rules.
